Dual Credit Courses	•	•			September 2023 - May 2024	Beginning in fall 2023, (under recent legislation) GEAR UP seniors may be eligible for the funding of dual credit courses identified thro institutional partners for certain pathways. In the event that a course is not covered under the program's provision and a course is liste the 2023-24 Ceneral Studies and Course Equivalency Transfer Agreement, GU funds may be used to cover the course. Reporting of s enrollment in all dual credit courses will be need to be tracked for reporting purposes.
