What is GEAR UP?



West Virginia GEAR UP (WVGU) is a program funded by the US Department of Education and stands for **G**aining **E**arly **A**wareness and **R**eadiness for **U**ndergraduate **P**rograms. More than 40 states across the United States have GEAR UP programs. In September 2021, WVGU received a \$24.5 million dollar grant to serve more than 17,000 middle and high school students across Boone, Clay, Lincoln, Logan, Mason, Mingo, Nicholas, Roane, Wayne, Webster and Wirt counties through 2028.

Who can participate?

Cohort students in the **classes of 2027 and 2028** who are graduating from participating high schools can participate in GEAR UP from their seventh grade year all the way through their first year of postsecondary education. For a list of participating schools, visit WVGearUp.org.

12th grade students graduating from participating high schools between **2022 and 2028** will receive services to help them transition to life after high school and through their first year of postsecondary education and/or training.



WVGU students receive academic enrichment, such as SAT/ACT prep, tutoring, dual credit and credit recovery opportunities, and STEM programming.



Students and families benefit from financial aid and college counseling, FAFSA completion workshops, scholarship information, and much more!
