Application, Review, Selection Processes

1. Interested students will need to complete the online application
 - Application is LIVE until **February 2nd!**
 - Applications will be sent to SCs no later than **February 3rd!**
2. Site Coordinators review and rank applicants using GUU Scoring Sheet
 - Score sheets should be completed and uploaded to GoAnywhere by **February 10th.**

Applicant Scoring Procedure

1. SCs will be sent a spreadsheet of their school's applicants.
2. GUU 2026 Applicant Scoring Sheet will be completed for each applicant.
 - a) Can be completed electronically via Excel or printed and completed manually.
3. All Scoring Sheets to be returned to Regional PDs via **GoAnywhere** by February 10th.

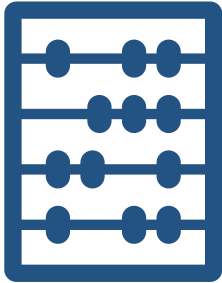

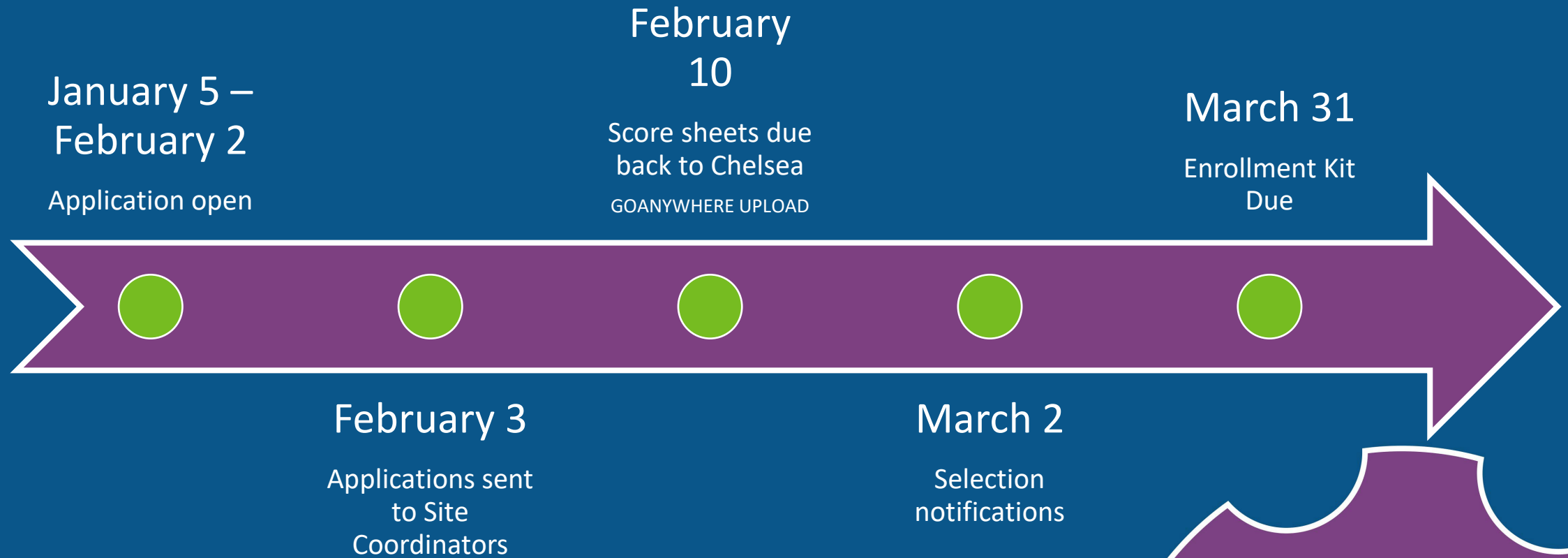
